Through this approach, it is hoped that individuals will get used to consistent good behavior, forming positive habits in everyday life (Mardiah Baginda & Pdi, 2022).

The main focus of character education in the educational environment is on attitudes, mindset, commitment and competence which are rooted in intelligence. Al-Biruni Science Elementary School in Panyileukan, Bandung City has implemented character education through the Bandung Masagi character program. The forms of activity are daily *ubudiyah* habits, Islamic *adab* habits, and example. The influence can be seen from the development of students' characters who show better attitudes. The character education concept
